

HOW TO ASK FOR (AND GET) STRONG LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION

- 1. Ask someone who knows you well and who will be able to discuss in specific detail what distinguishes you.
- 2. Ask well in advance of the deadline.
- 3. Ask: "Do you feel you know me well enough to write a strong letter of recommendation for xyz scholarship?"
- 4. Provide a current list of your strengths (see attached form).
- 5. Attach a copy of any essay you were required to write for the scholarship application.
- 6. Provide information on the focus of the scholarship.
- 7. If the letter of recommendation is to be confidential, provide an addressed, stamped envelope.
- 8. Mind your manners! Thank the person and be sure to let them know if you are awarded the scholarship!!!
- 9. If you are awarded a scholarship, be sure to send a formal thank you letter to the scholarship committee,
